THE BIBLE

Luke 15:11–32; 2 Corinthians 5:17–19

THE BIG IDEA

We grow when we know we're loved.

WHAT? *What are we talking about?*

NOW WHAT? *What do we do about it?*

QUESTIONS

- Would you rather fill your house with plastic plants you never have to think about or living plants you get to care for?
- If you were a plant (either living or plastic) what would make you feel loved and cared for?
- As a human (not a plant) what makes you feel loved and cared for?

- When is it difficult for you to believe you are unconditionally loved?
- Which of these statements resonates with you more and why?

- How can this group be more of a place where people experience God's unconditional love?
