- Share with the group about a recent, meaningful experience you've had with someone you love. What happened? Why did it mean so much to you? Did this impact your outlook on life?

RESPONSE | Tell Me More

Encourage group members to start a text conversation with someone they want to connect with this week. The only goal is to be intentional about showing interest in what they have to say and asking good follow-up questions. Intentionally hear someone else's story so they know there is nothing more important to you than hearing what they have to say.
