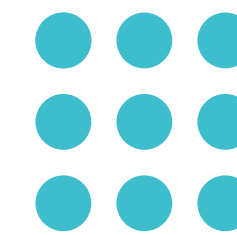

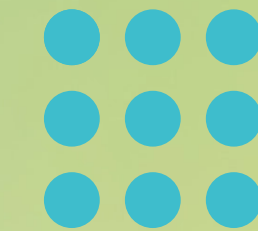

Grace Place Kids provided several opportunities in 2022, to accomplish this mission outside of our Sunday experience.

We hosted a spring **Kids Movie Night** for **165 children** and two **Summer Break Outs** in a local park for over **100 kids** and parents. Kids Hope Mentoring launched this fall with **25 mentors** meeting weekly with a child in our two local elementary schools.

Grace Place Kids leaders have a heart for Jesus and kids.

They take time to build relationships and invest in the next generation who is the church today. Leaders who serve in kids know it is for a greater purpose in growing the Kingdom.



Volunteer Highlight: Robert DeWall

What does it mean to serve in children's ministry at Grace Place?

It's hard to put into words. It's God blessing me. I felt the need to give back, but it's turned into so much more. I benefit more from serving than anything. It builds me up and recharges my life. These kids can wear you out, but serving emotionally and mentally recharges me for the coming week.

Seeing the kids' faces light up is the best feeling in the world. They feel safe and secure at church.

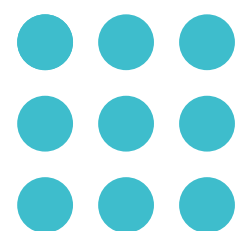
Our serve team started out as just people you see occasionally, but it's turned

into a real family. We know each other and pray for each other regularly.

I have a long history of health problems and most recently encountered a massive stroke on November 18, which required surgery and extensive hospitalization. I was told that I wouldn't be able to see or walk but my God is big and powerful. While in a CAT scan, I kept repeating Psalm 23 and God's peace came over me. The next day, I told the doctor that church is coming on Sunday and I have to be there to serve.

God has a bigger plan for me and I am here to serve him and his children. If it's just one person that I can help by serving so that their parents can go to church and grow then I'm okay with that. I have a purpose.

At Grace Place, God is strengthening my faith and obedience to Him to do what he asks of me.

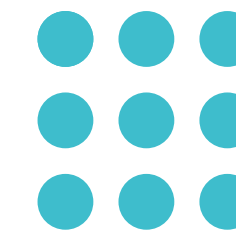

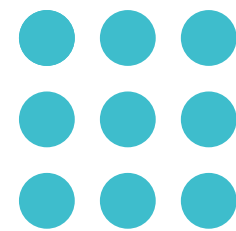
